

2022 # Served: We funded the distribution of over 10,000 books across Yolo County through library programs in our region's most underserved communities. We also funded access to broad digital library resources such as Beanstack and Tumblebooks.

#3: Providing Financial Support for Summer and Winter Reading Programs County-Wide.

An example of our impactful giving includes a significant gift to United Way to partner with the Yolo County Library to ensure Yolo County's participation in the Dolly Parton Imagination Library's inaugural programming. Those funds were leveraged into a policy win for the entire state that ensures that children in our county can receive a book a month until they reach the age of five.

Proposed Use of Funds

With these funds, we will continue improving literacy across the county. We will leverage the county library's buying power to give free quality books (that cost us a fraction of the retail price) for needing families and communities to build home libraries. With \$10,000, we can purchase approximately 2,500 high-quality, age-appropriate books. Books will be distributed through various library programs like the summer and winter reading programs and the bookmobile, and unique collaborative community and library programming like Stories on Stage.
